Description			

Provide a short description of the event and its activities.

As part of the CERV program, the Łodygowice municipality aims to create a long-term network of cooperation with other partners involved in the consortium. Our municipality's priority is to continuously build ties with the five partners in the consortium in the economic, social, tourist and cultural areas, and to take on additional opportunities for projects with European funding.

On 23-25 September 2022. The Łodygowice Municipality hosted delegations from Gyöngyös (Hungary), Lendva (Slovenia), Melnik (Czech Republic) and Losonc (Slovakia) and Târgu Secuiesc (Romania). During the weekend, the guests had the opportunity to get to know the Łodygowice Municipality through a series of well-organised activities.

On the first day of the weekend, the delegates visited the park and palace complex, which includes the historic Palace and Outbuildings. After lunch, and during the official conference held in the afternoon, the guests had the opportunity to taste local products.

On the second day of the event, excursions were organised. First, our guests were taken to the Żywiec Lake, where a joint walk took place. This was followed by a tasting of local products prepared by the ladies of the Zarzecze Rural Housewives' Circle from Zarzecze. The housewives took the opportunity to talk about their activities in the Łodygowice municipality and to present regional costumes, which were very much to the liking of the delegates. After the visit to Zarzecz, we went to Mount Skrzyczne - the highest peak in the Beskid Śląski massif. The attraction delighted the guests. In the evening, we went to the historic church in Łodygowice. The evening ended with a performance by the "Magurzanie" Regional Ensemble, who presented an artistic programme.

Thanks to the activities organised and the time spent together, the delegations of the invited delegations had the opportunity to get to know each other personally and to learn more about the traditions and customs of the Łodygowice Municipality.

As part of the programme and activities organised, the members of the delegation, in addition to the partnership, made friends and discussed in more detail the professional challenges they were facing, thus giving the delegates an overview of the specific characteristics of each participating partner. Furthermore, the most important effect of the event was that the guests were able to get to know all the qualities of the Łodygowice Municipality from different perspectives.

The conclusions of the activities were communicated through several communication channels. For example, through posters that were placed in public display cabinets in the Łodygowice Municipality, residents were informed of the implementation of the project. Representatives of the municipality and experts who may be involved in the next phase of the project were also informed about the possibilities for long-term cooperation. Information about the project was posted on the Łodygowice Municipality website.
