Description			
<i>Provide a short description of the event and its activities.</i>			
<p>On the first day of the weekend, the delegates had the opportunity to discover the unique historical centre of our town and to visit Molnár Józsiás Park and Wilhelm Wegener Park, which are considered among the most important promenade parks in the town. The group also visited the Erzsébet Orphanage Institute in Three Chairs, founded by Baron Stephanie Szentkereszty, where, in addition to visiting the art therapy workshop, they could buy local artifacts and taste traditional dishes. After the walk through the town, each participant took part in a joint seminar presenting their own town,</p>			

highlighting its particularities, traditions, tourist and historical features.

On the second day of the event in Târgu Secuiesc, a guided tour was organised to the Bálványos Baths, which are only 20 km away from Târgu Secuiesc and where, in addition to the natural attractions, guests could taste different types of mineral waters. Our guided tour continued to the 'Big Pivots Hill' in Moacăsa, where we watched the Szeklar Gallop, a preliminary round of the national race in Budapest. During this event, members of the delegation were also able to see the folk-rock opera performance entitled "Saint Ladislaus, the Knight King", presented by the National Equestrian Theatre.

Through the organised activities and the time spent together, the delegations of the invited cities had the opportunity to get to know each other personally and to get better acquainted with the traditions and customs of the city of the courtyards.

During the framework of the programme and organised activities, the members of the delegations, in addition to the partnership, made friendships and discussed in more detail the professional challenges they face, thus giving the delegations an overview of the particularities of each participating city. In addition, the most important impact of the event was the fact that the guests could get to know from different perspectives on all the qualities of the easternmost Hungarian majority town in the Carpathian Basin, Târgu Secuiesc - the town of courtyards.
